## SCORING

**COLUMN 1 – Current Practice Score:** 3=I do regularly; 2=some things I do, some I do not; 1=things I don't do

**COLUMN 2 – Current Effectiveness Score:** 3=Things I do effectively; 2=Things I could do but could be more effective; 1= I don't do these things

**COLUMN 3** –Add column 1 and column 2 and record the results in column 3

**COLUMN 4 – Priority:** 3=these things are priorities in my team; 2=these things should be priorities in my team; 1=this section is not relevant to my team.

### Review of Priority (Column 4):

- If you scored a **6**, you feel that you generally use the strategy. You are implementing strategies that are aligned with your priorities.
- A score of below a **4** signals that you may want to make some adjustments to what you are doing.
- A total score of **2** indicates an opportunity to take a risk and try something new.
- Be sure you have the last three columns completed for these steps.

The next step of our self-assessment is to discuss it with your PLC.

- Compare the team's responses to your self-assessment.
- Rank the three most important things your team should be working on.
- Be prepared to justify your responses, as everyone should be working on aligned activities.
